Section 6(1)(a)

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. ICI Chemicals & Polymers Limited (registered in England and Wales under company number 0358535) (the Licensee), having its registered office at The Heath, Runcorn, Cheshire, WA7 4QF, Great Britain, is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to ICI Chemicals & Polymers Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 10 August 2007 the Licensee applied to the Authority to have the Licence revoked and the Authority has agreed to that request.

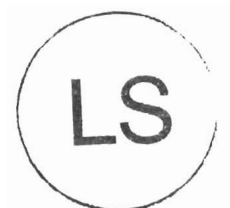

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(a) Electricity
Act to ICI Chemicals & Polymers Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by ICI Chemicals & Polymers Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Electricity Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989.

Decision

The Authority will be revoking the Licence on 12 November 2007.
