**Review of industry code governance**

The Independent Gas Transporters' Uniform Network Code (iGT UNC) Modification Panel have asked me to write to you in response to Ofgem's review of industry code governance.

The iGT UNC is the newest of these codes, having only come into existence in May 2007. Its implementation followed extensive work by the Independent Gas Transporters to consolidate twelve individual codes into one. This work was supported and welcomed by the gas shipping community.

The iGT UNC is currently reviewing its own governance procedures via a Review Group consisting of many shippers and iGTs. This has included a review of the Modification Rules and a series of changes are being progressed that it is anticipated will lead to the more efficient administration of the iGT UNC.

The Modification Panel welcome being kept informed of Ofgem's review and Members are likely to accept your invitation to the Powering the Energy Debate event. Should you require further information about the iGT UNC please do not hesitate to contact me.
