Section 6

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Cinergy Global Trading Limited (company registration number 3776925), having its registered office at Cinergy Global Trading Limited C/O PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, Queen Victoria House, PO Box 88, Guildhall Road, Hull, HU1 1HH, Great Britain, is the holder of an electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Cinergy Global Trading Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 13 November 2007 Cinergy Global Trading Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 10 of the electricity supply licence have been made.

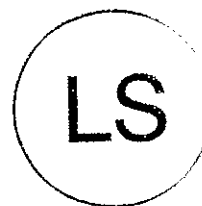

Decision


The Authority will be revoking the Licence on 11 January 2008.
