Section 7A

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. ConocoPhillips Petroleum Company UK Limited (company registration number 00792712) having its registered office at Portman House, 2 Portman Street, London, W1H 6DU, is the holder of a gas shipper licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to ConocoPhillips Petroleum Company UK Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter received in February 2008 ConocoPhillips Petroleum Company UK Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

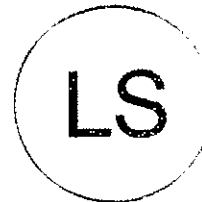



NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act
1986 to ConocoPhillips Petroleum Company UK Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by ConocoPhillips Petroleum Company UK Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its gas shipper Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision


The Authority will revoke the Licence on 29 April 2008.
