Notice of revocation of licence

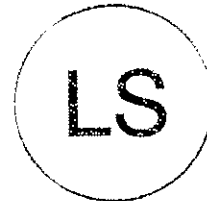
Whereas

- A. International Power Plc (company registration number 02366963) having its registered office at Senator House, 85 Queen Victoria Street, London, EC4V 4DP, Great Britain, is the holder of a gas shipper licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to International Power Plc where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter received in February 2008 International Power Plc requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 29 April 2008 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act
1986 to International Power Plc**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by International Power Plc ("the Licensee") to revoke its gas shipper Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision

The Authority will revoke the Licence on 29 April 2008.

Notice of Revocation was issued to the Licensee on 27 March 2008.

Reasons for Decision

The Licensee requested in writing to the Authority that the Licence should be revoked in accordance with paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 2 of the Licence by letter received in February 2008.
