

## **NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A GAS ACT 1986**

### **Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority to grant consent to Wales and West Utilities Limited**

**Whereas** on 12 of May 2008 the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority granted consent to Wales and West Utilities Limited (the "licensee"), Company Number 05046971 of Wales and West House, Spooner Close Coedkernew, Newport, South Wales NP10 8FZ under Standard Special Condition A36 (Restriction on Activity and Financial Ring Fencing) ("SSC A36") of the gas transporter licence granted by the Authority to the licensee, on the licensee's request.

**Now** in accordance with section 38A of the Gas Act 1986, the reasons for the decision of the Authority to grant the SSC A36 consent are to enable the licensee to make certain service arrangements and enter into agreements (including an agreement for provision of offtakes and general assets maintenance services to Transco plc (now known as National Grid Gas plc), and to enter into emergency assistance agreements for the provision of emergency services to gas transporters under Standard Special Condition A41 (Emergency Services to or on Behalf of Another Gas Transporter)), which were referred to in the consent; and to provide the agreed services.
