

Consent given by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority pursuant to amended standard condition 54 (Specific restriction of activity) of the Electricity Distribution Licence treated as granted under section 6(1)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 to EDF Energy (IDNO) Ltd

Whereas:

- 1 EDF Energy (IDNO) Ltd (the "Licensee") is the holder of a licence (the "Licence") treated as granted under section 6(1)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 (the "Act").
- 2 The Licensee has requested that the Authority grant consent pursuant to amended standard condition 54 ("SLC 54") of the Licence for the procurement, adoption and distribution of electricity through relevant assets which will be installed in the Stratford area of East London and has provided the information required under SLC 54, including a map depicting the land area on which the assets will be installed.
- 3 The Authority considers that the consent requested should be granted for the reasons outlined below:
 - a. The consent will allow the Licensee to establish and subsequently operate the electricity distribution infrastructure required for the Olympic Park and Stratford City developments referred to in its application for the Licence;
 - b. The Authority is satisfied that the consent will not have anti-competitive effects or be contrary to the interests of consumers.

Now the Authority consents hereby as follows:

- 1 In accordance with and for the purpose of paragraph 1 of SLC 54 the Authority hereby consents, with effect from 27 January 2009, to the procurement, adoption and distribution of electricity through relevant assets which will be installed in the Stratford area of East London as specified in the map and other information provided by the licensee to the Authority.
- 2 This consent has effect from 27 January 2009 and constitutes notice for the purpose of section 49A of the Act.
