
## **Review of Industry Code Governance – Environment and Code Objectives**

This response to your 16<sup>th</sup> June open letter is being submitted on behalf of the UNC Modification Panel.

Panel Members do not consider that any UNC Modification Proposal raised to date would have been expected to have a material impact on greenhouse gas emissions such that a specific assessment of the associated costs or benefits would have been justified. However, they recognise that such a Proposal may arise in future. Given this, they have asked the Governance Workstream to consider the practicality of identifying the type of Proposal which might merit such an assessment, in line with your proposals. Having identified the type of Proposal which might merit assessment, the Workstream has also been asked to consider how such an assessment might be undertaken. The Panel believes that this should help to ensure that it is in a position to comply with the suggestions in your open letter.

The Panel trust that this response is helpful but would welcome any suggestions regarding further steps that might usefully be taken in this respect.
