- UKBCSE coordinated activities across trade associations

- Working with Ofgem and DECC on detailed implementation programme



Pragmatic approach

- Introduce by 1 April 2010
- What must be done to achieve deadline
- What might not be possible or sensible in the initial phases
- Sensible allocation of responsibilities
- Looking for synergy with other financial incentives



Introduction by April 2010

- Progressing with 'working assumptions'
- Manual systems
 - Lower numbers to start
- Deemed export (until Smart Meters)
 - >50kW to be fully metered
- Generator responsible for G Meter
- Minimise switching
- Smooth transition from RO to FiT



Open Questions

- Accreditation and registration
- Ownership assignation of payment
- Export tariff opt in/out
- Dealing with fraud
- Levelisation
 - Make FiTs attractive fair allocation of costs
 - Synergy with Social Tariff 'Equalisation'?
