Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Great Yarmouth Power Limited (registered in England and Wales under company number 03233751) (the Licensee), having its registered office at Windmill Hill Business Park, Whitehill Way, Swindon, Wiltshire, SN5 6PB, Great Britain, is the holder of an electricity generation licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Great Yarmouth Power Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 17 May 2010 the Licensee applied to the Authority to have the Licence revoked and the Authority has agreed to that request.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 16 July 2010 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(a) Electricity
Act to Great Yarmouth Power Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by Great Yarmouth Power Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its electricity generation licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989.

Decision
