Section 7A

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. SPE (company registration number 0471.811.664) having its registered office at Boulevard du Regent, 47, B-1000, Bruxelles is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 23rd August 2007.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to SPE where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 2nd July 2010 SPE requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 30th August 2010 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas
