

Following its energy supply market probe, Ofgem introduced a licence condition requiring the major energy suppliers to produce accounts segmenting their supply and generation activities 6 months after their financial year end. When publishing their numbers, companies are required to provide an explanation of how they define the terms revenue, cost and profit.
