Notice of revocation of licence

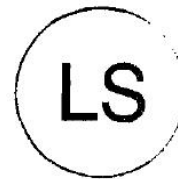
Whereas

- A. Mynt Supplies Limited (company registration number 05898289) having its registered office at 51 Paragon Place, Norwich, Norfolk, NR2 4BL, Great Britain, is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 25th March 2010.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Mynt Supplies Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 28th July 2010 Mynt Supplies Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 18th September the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas
Act 1986 to Mynt Supplies Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by Mynt Supplies Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its gas shipper Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 25th March 2010 under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision

The Authority will revoke the Licence on 18th September.

Notice of Revocation was issued to the Licensee on 19th August 2010.

Reasons for Decision
