## Notice of revocation of Gas shipper licence


#### Whereas

- A. Enron Capital & Trade Resources Limited (company registration number 02415924) having its registered office at Pricewaterhousecoopers, 12 Plumtree Court, London, EC4A 4HT, Great Britain is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 12 August 1997.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. Paragraph 1(e)(ii) of Schedule 2 of the Licence provides that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority"), may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Enron Capital & Trade Resources Limited; where it has not commenced business as a gas shipper within a period of 3 years from the date on which the licence came into effect.
- C. By a letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 2010 the Authority confirmed to Enron Capital & Trade Resources Limited, that having failed to provide satisfactory evidence that the licensable activity would commence the licence would be revoked.

## Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 19<sup>th</sup> November 2010 the licence shall be revoked.

## Notice pursuant to Section 38A(1)(a) of the Gas Act 1986

## Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority revoking the Gas Shipper Licence treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 to Enron Capital & Trade Resources Limited

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") will revoke the Gas Shipper Licence held by Enron Capital & Trade Resources Limited ("the Licence") treated as granted on 12<sup>th</sup> August 1997 under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.
