Notice of revocation of licence

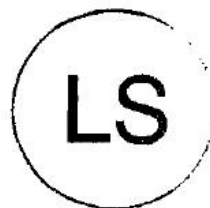
Whereas

- A. 730 Energy Limited (company registration number 05011612), having its registered office at A2 Yeoman Gate, Yeoman Way, Worthing, West Sussex, BN13 3QZ, Great Britain is the holder of an electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*) to it on 17th February 2004.
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to 730 Energy Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 8th November 2010 730 Energy Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 27th December 2010 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) Electricity
Act to 730 Energy Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by 730 Energy Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Electricity Supply Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 17th February 2004 under Section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989.

Decision

The Authority will be revoking the Licence on 27th December 2010.
