**Section 6**

**Notice of revocation of licence**

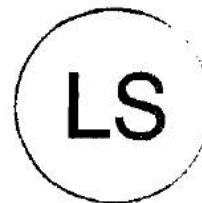
***Whereas***

- A. Essential Power Limited (company registration number 04588213) having its registered office at 28 Holly Hill, Bassett, Southampton, Hampshire, SO16 7EW, Great Britain is the holder of an electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*) to it on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2003.
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. Paragraph 1(e) of Schedule 2 of the Licence provides that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority"), may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Essential Power Limited; where it has not commenced business as an electricity supplier within a period of 5 years from the date on which the licence came into effect or has ceased business as an electricity supplier for a period of 5 years.
- C. By a letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> November 2010 the Authority confirmed to Essential Power Limited, that having failed to provide satisfactory evidence that the licensable activity would commence the licence would be revoked.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.

***Notice of Revocation***

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 27<sup>th</sup> December 2010 the licence shall be revoked.

**NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989**

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority  
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) Electricity  
Act to Essential Power Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") will revoke the Electricity Supply Licence held by Essential Power Limited ("the Licence") treated as granted on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2003 under Section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989.

**Decision**

The Authority will be revoking the Licence on 27<sup>th</sup> December 2010.

Notice of Revocation was issued to the Licensee on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2010.

**Reasons for Decision**

In accordance with paragraph 1(e)(i) of Schedule 2 of the Licence, the licensee has not commenced business as a electricity supplier within a period of 5 years from the date on which the Licence came into effect.
