## Notice of revocation of licence


### Whereas

- A. International Power Plc (company registration number 02366963), having its registered office at Senator House, 85 Queen Victoria Street, London, EC4V 4DP, Great Britain is the holder of an electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*) to it on 1<sup>st</sup> May 1998.
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the Authority) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to International Power Plc where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 11<sup>th</sup> November 2010 International Power Plc requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.
