Notice of revocation of licence

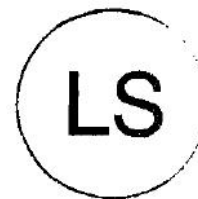
Whereas

- A. E.ON Energy Trading NL Staff Company 2 B.V. (previously E.ON D-Gas B.V.) (company registration number 27189951) having its registered office at Capelseweg 400, 3068AX Rotterdam, The Netherlands is the holder of a gas shipper licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 24th January 2001.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to E.ON Energy Trading NL Staff Company 2 B.V. (previously E.ON D-Gas B.V.) where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 17th November 2010 E.ON Energy Trading NL Staff Company 2 B.V. (previously E.ON D-Gas B.V.) requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 17th January 2011 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(2) of the Gas
Act 1986 to E.ON Energy Trading NL Staff Company 2 B.V. (previously
E.ON D-Gas B.V.)**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by E.ON Energy Trading NL Staff Company 2 B.V. (previously E.ON D-Gas B.V.) ("the Licensee") to revoke its gas shipper Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 24th January 2001 under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision

The Authority will revoke the Licence on 17th January 2011.
