**Section 7A**

**Notice of revocation of licence**

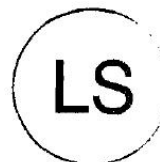
***Whereas***

- A. Total Gas Marketing Limited (company registration number 02641991) having its registered office at 26 Farringdon Street, London, EC4A 4AB, Great Britain is the holder of a gas supplier licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(1) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1996.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. Paragraph 1(f)(v) of Schedule 2 of the Licence provides that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority"), may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Total Gas Marketing Limited; where the licensee becomes subject to an order for winding-up.
- C. By a letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> February 2011 the Authority confirmed to Total Gas Marketing Limited, that the licence would be revoked.

***Notice of Revocation***

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 21<sup>st</sup> March 2011 the licence shall be revoked.

**NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986**

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority  
revoking the Gas Supplier Licence treated as granted under section 7A(1)  
of the Gas Act 1986 to Total Gas Marketing Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") will revoke the Gas Supplier Licence held by Total Gas Marketing Limited ("the Licence") treated as granted on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1996 under Section 7A(2) of the Gas Act 1986.
