#### Section 7A

## Notice of revocation of licence

#### Whereas

- A. 730 Energy Limited (company registration number 05011612), having its registered office at A2 Yeoman Gate, Yeoman Way, Worthing, West Sussex, BN13 3QZ, Great Britain is the holder of a gas supplier licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(1)(a) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2004.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the Authority) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to 730 Energy Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 28<sup>th</sup> February 2011 730 Energy Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made under section 7A(9) of the Act have been made.


