Section 7A

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Affinity Power Limited (company registration number 04498201), having its registered office at 5 Deneshey Road, Meols, Wirral, Merseyside, CH47 3AA, Great Britain is the holder of a gas supplier licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(1)(a) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 27th September 2002.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Affinity Power Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 28th February 2011 Affinity Power Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made under section 7A(9) of the Act have been made.

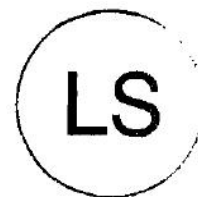

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(1) of the Gas
Act 1986 to Affinity Power Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by Affinity Power Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Gas Supplier Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 27th September 2002 under Section 7A(1) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision

The Authority will revoke the Licence on 20th April 2011.
