Notice of revocation of licence

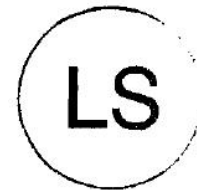
Whereas

- A. Utilitease Limited (company registration number 04460361), having its registered office at A2 Yeoman Gate, Yeoman Way, Worthing, West Sussex, BN13 3QZ, Great Britain is the holder of a gas supplier licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(1)(a) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 9th February 2004.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Utilitease Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By an email dated 28th February 2011 Utilitease Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made under section 7A(9) of the Act have been made.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 20th April 2011 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(1) of the Gas
Act 1986 to Utilitease Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by Utilitease Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Gas Supplier Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 9th February 2004 under Section 7A(1) of the Gas Act 1986.
