

## Application Process Overview: Fuelled Stations

Clear project proposal & planning permission / Section 36 consent in place (if applicable)

Consult relevant Ofgem guidance documents e.g. Renewables Obligation: Fuel Measurement and Sampling & Renewables Obligation: Guidance for Generators.  
Ofgem would be happy to outline the FMS agreement process by telephone at this stage if required.

Make an application to Ofgem online via the Renewables & CHP Register. Fuel Measurement and Sampling (FMS) proposal is uploaded, in the relevant format, at this stage.

### FMS Process

Stations using 100% Biomass (by energy content) fuels where biomass is the only fuel utilised in the generating station can make contact with Ofgem to discuss whether FMS procedures will be required or if submission of a fuel specification will be sufficient.

Anaerobic Digestion stations submit the 'AD Confirmation of Feedstocks template' to declare feedstocks utilised and that sewage is not used in the digester.

- FMS Process:**
- Initial review of proposed procedures by Ofgem.
  - Comments sent to operator for consideration in updating FMS questionnaire.
  - Updated Questionnaire document submitted for review.
- Nb. This is an iterative process and repeated until agreement is reached.

Sign off by Manager: Biomass, Co-Firing and Waste. Site advised of data to be supplied to Ofgem on a monthly basis.

Application and eligibility checks.

Once application / eligibility checks are complete and FMS procedures agreed a final check of the complete application is undertaken by 'Head of Renewables and CHP'.

Site advised of (pre) accreditation decision e.g. approval or further queries.
