Project TransmiT: invitation to stakeholder event – progress update

Ofgem is holding an open event to provide an update on the progress of our work on potential transmission charging options under Project TransmiT. The event will be held on **Thursday, 11 August from 1.30pm to 5pm** at our London office, 9 Millbank, London SW1P 3GE.

Project TransmiT is Ofgem's independent and open review of transmission charging and associated connection arrangements. We issued an open letter¹ on 7 July 2011, setting out our decision to launch a Significant Code Review (SCR) on electricity transmission charging issues under TransmiT. That letter also invited expressions of interest from those with relevant technical expertise, to take part in a technical working group that will support the development of the technical detail of the options for change.

The first of these technical working groups took place on 20 July 2011 at our Glasgow offices. Five further meetings are planned between now and the end of September. The agenda, minutes and relevant presentations for each meeting are published on our web forum².

In addition to the technical working groups, we have also initiated detailed modelling work to identify the likely impacts of the different potential options for change. We have committed to taking this work forward in an open and transparent way, making available the outcomes of our modelling work as that work progresses.

This letter invites interested stakeholders to an event we are holding on 11 August. Please note that this event is not open to the media. The purpose of the stakeholder event is to provide an update on the progress of the technical working group and also on the detailed modelling work that our consultants, Redpoint, are undertaking.
