**Use of system charges for distributed generators: publication of consultations on a time-limited exemption for pre-2005 generators and the way forward on higher voltage generation charging**

Today we have published two consultations in relation to use of system charges for distributed generators (DG). These are available at: <http://www.ofgem.gov.uk/Networks/ElecDist/Policy/DistChrgs/Pages/DistChrgs.aspx>.

The first consultation sets out our rationale for implementing a time-limited exemption for pre-2005 connected DG and consults on the proposed length of such an exemption. We also discuss the arrangements for implementing a time-limited exemption.

The second consultation explains that we are reconsidering the Distribution Network Operators' proposed Extra High Voltage Distribution Charging Methodology (EDCM) for DG due to the impact of a time-limited exemption on charges for pre-2005 DG and due to the responses we received to our previous consultation. It outlines options for how the proposed EDCM could be amended. We also set out a proposed timetable for further developing the methodology in consultation with stakeholders, before ultimately making a decision on the EDCM for DG.

These consultations follow on from our letter of 11 August 2011 where we set out our current thinking to apply a time-limited exemption for pre-2005 DG and to defer implementation of the EDCM for DG to 1 April 2013 (or possibly later).

Both consultations close on **5 December 2011**. We welcome comments from all industry stakeholders on the proposals and thoughts outlined in these documents.
