#### **CHP LEC RECONCILIATION 2012**

The 2012 reconciliation process will take place soon after 1 July 2012 following receipt of the new CHPQA certificate details directly from CHPQA (the accreditation body). This letter is a brief summary of what reconciliation is and highlights any actions you might need to take before reconciliation begins. **If you are not claiming CHP LECs please ignore the content of this letter.** 

#### What is reconciliation?

CHP LECs are issued to individual generating stations based on monthly output data¹ submitted within two months following the month of generation deadline (as published in the certificate issue schedule) and the QPO/TPO ratio of the station. CHPQA assesses a stations QPO/TPO ratio annually. Where a station's QPO/TPO ratio has changed or where monthly output data was submitted late or has been amended, the number of CHP LECs issued during the previous year will be wrong.

To rectify this, reconciliation is performed annually to assess the correct number of CHP LECs to issue based on the new QPO/TPO ratio and the correct output data for a station. Therefore, if you would like any late or amended data taken into account when reconciliation is performed please complete the form in Annex 1 to this letter and return it to the contact details above <u>before 30 June 2012</u>. Please also make sure that all changes requested are reflected within your account on the Renewables & CHP Register.

If the number of CHP LECs issued during the reconciliation span (1 January 2011 to 31 March 2012, or 1 January 2011 to the day your CHPQA certificate was revoked) needs to be corrected you shall be contacted directly. If reconciliation finds that an insufficient or excessive number of CHP LECs were issued, the difference will be corrected. Additional CHP LECs will be issued or CHP LECs already issued will be withheld on future GQCHP electricity generated via the Renewables and CHP Register. The Climate Change Levy exemption for CHP: Guidance for exporting 'good-quality' CHP generators and suppliers published on the Ofgem website, <a href="www.ofgem.gov.uk">www.ofgem.gov.uk</a> provides further information on how reconciliation is performed.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Please note an electrical equivalent of motive power is not an eligible output for CHP LECs. CHP LECs may only be claimed for good-quality CHP electricity generation where at least some of the electricity is exported from site. If no export meter and connection to the grid is in place CHP LECs should not be claimed. ## Consumption & Information Declarations

Please ensure that you sign the appropriate 2012/13 Consumption Declaration (i.e. fully efficient or partially efficient) and Information Declaration for your station(s) via the Renewables & CHP Register <a href="www.renewablesandchp.ofgem.gov.uk">www.renewablesandchp.ofgem.gov.uk</a>. You will note that for each station there is both a fully and a partially efficient Consumption Declaration available to sign. Please only sign the appropriate declaration according to your CHPQA certificate. As soon as we receive the 2012/13 CHPQA certificate details the incorrect Consumption Declaration for your station(s) will be removed. Please note, if the declarations are not submitted online CHP LECs will not be issued.

### April 2012 CHP LEC Issue

April 2012 and subsequent months CHP LECs will be issued shortly after reconciliation is complete. The reconciliation calculations will be performed as quickly as possible but please bear with us during this period.
