Improving the Reporting Transparency of Large Energy Suppliers

Centrica welcome Ofgem's ongoing work to improve the transparency of vertically integrated energy companies' financial publications. We believe the recent BDO investigation and this subsequent consultation are an important vehicle for delivering reform, and believe that Ofgem's current proposals will improve the confidence the public have in the way in which vertically integrated companies operate.

The proposal to exclude "costs" from the reconciliation is both sensible and appropriate given fuel, direct and indirect costs are not separately disclosed by suppliers in their Group accounts. Furthermore, we have no objection to describing which segment our Renewables Obligation and Feed in Tariff costs reside. We therefore support these latest minor amendments and believe the wider package of reform now proposed will improve the reporting transparency of large energy suppliers.
