Wholesale Markets

- Government is continuing with **Electricity Market Reform** (EMR)
- Ofgem has today released the **Electricity Capacity Assessment** Report
- Ofgem published Consultation on Electricity Balancing SCR
- We continue to monitor **electricity wholesale market liquidity** and intend to issue an update by the end of the year



Wholesale Markets

- The **Transmission Constraint Licence Condition** expected to come into force at end of this month
- Proposed Final Policy Decision on gas SCR published this July
- Ofgem issued open letter on use of gas interconnectors on Monday



Smarter Markets

- Government policy is to roll out smart metering across GB by 2019
- Ofgem work programme to develop smarter markets from the platform of smart metering

 We are engaging with DECC on the regulatory issues relating to roll out



Retail markets

- Following our Retail Market Review (RMR) we are developing proposals on:
 - Simplifying tariffs and making them easier to compare and understand
 - Improving information to customers
 - Licence binding standards of conduct
 - Extending existing protections to a wider group of nondomestic customers

We will be publishing updated proposals soon
