Consultation on proposed licence modifications to Charge Restriction Conditions (CRC) 13 and 15 of the electricity distribution licence

I attach a notice about proposed modifications to licence conditions CRC 13 (Low Carbon Networks) and CRC 15 (Excluded Services). We are seeking views on our proposals which put in place a mechanism to return to consumers a proportion of royalty revenue equal to the proportion of funding which consumers provided to the project.

We propose to ensure customers benefit from Low Carbon Networks (LCN) Fund projects. As projects are largely funded by customers, they should receive a share of revenue earned from royalties resulting from intellectual property.

This letter constitutes notice under section 11A(2) of the Electricity Act 1989.
