Re: OFGEM Consultation-ECO Scores

npower have considered the information provided in the Ofgem Consultation on Energy Company Obligation (ECO) Scores regarding the removal of the P-Value calculation method when calculating ECO Scores for measures which are partially installed to the walls of a premise.

npower recognise that Ofgem have identified an important issue and we agree that being as accurate as possible is an important part of the ECO.

npower's preferred approach to calculating ECO Scores for measures which are partially installed to the walls of a premise is to use the alternative wall and extension methodology for these circumstances, rather than the area weighted U-value methodology.

We hope this information will form part of the decision making process in the future.
