<u>Ofgem consultation on DCUSA DCP124 – Third Party Network – National Connection Terms</u> <u>Amendment</u>

Our response (non confidential) is as follows:-

As a Supplier, our standard terms and conditions include the required DCUSA wording which signposts customers to the NTC.

Our understanding is that The Electricity and Gas (Internal Markets) Regulations 2011 essentially requires a Distribution Exemption Holders to set out terms of connection and use to its customers who require direct market access, which means the DEH's connection terms need to account for the terms placed upon it by the LDSO to which it is connected.

We are therefore neutral on this DCUSA change as we feel it is a matter for LDSOs and DEHs to determine.
