Carnedd Wen Wind Farm licence modification: decision letter

On 21 March 2014, Ofgem published "Statutory Consultation on the modification of the electricity generation licence of Carnedd Wen Wind Farm Limited" (the Statutory Consultation)¹. The Statutory Consultation set out the text of the licence condition, stating that, subject to responses, we were minded to introduce the condition into the licence held by Carnedd Wen Wind Farm Limited.

We received one response to the consultation, which closed on 22 April 2014. This response was supportive of our decision to make the proposed modification. After considering the response to our Statutory Consultation we consider the reasons given in our statutory consultation remain our valid reasons for this decision and it remains appropriate to for the licence modifications to be made in line with those proposed. This is set out in the decision notice published alongside this letter.

Following the publication of the decision notice today, any relevant party that wishes to appeal the Authority's decision to the Competition and Markets Authority may do so on or before 27 May 2014.

On or after 20 June 2014 the Authority proposes to issue a direction to meet all the requirements of the condition. This will relate to paragraph AA.2 and will switch on the licence condition on or after 23 June 2014.
