I welcome the chance to submit. I am the Chairman of a local anti-windfarm community group in the midlands of Ireland and we are vehemently opposed to the Wind Export Project being proposed by Irish State and Private Companies in Ireland for the Export of Wind Energy to UK, which is being facilitated by a Memorandum of Understanding between Ireland and the UK.

The Irish Government has failed to provide adequate protection to its citizens from the onslaught of Wind Development and has not adequately consulted with communities before embarking on such a proposal.

There are now 200 groups (Pylons and Windfarms) that have come together in opposition to these proposals¹.

It is our intention to disrupt, derail and prevent these proposals from going ahead.
