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Consultation on changes to the National Grid Electricity Transmission plc's electricity transmission licence to publish the Electricity Ten Year Statement (ETYS)

Dear Angelita,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on your consultation: changes to NGET's electricity licence to publish the ETYS. This response is provided on behalf of RWE Npower Renewables Limited, a fully owned subsidiary of RWE Innogy GmbH.

We have observed that realigning the SYS and the ODIS to the single ETYS has resulted in some loss of information (consultation question 5):

- We were advised that the ETYS would contain all the technical data that was previously available in the SYS. The ETYS no longer seems to provide information about the demand at each of the GSPs, which was provided in the SYS.
- SYS updates included a list of new proposed developments on the transmission system. This data is now not included in the TNQCU or the ETYS. Instead the user is directed to the Transmission Reinforcement Works Register on the NGET website, which is itself not updated on a quarterly basis and not in line with the TNQCU. In fact it hasn't been updated since 28th August 2013.

We request that these inconsistencies of the new ETYS with the previous SYS/OTIS process should be addressed.
