# GAS SECURITY OF SUPPLY SIGNIFICANT CODE REVIEW LICENCE MODIFICATIONS: IMPLEMENTATION DATE FOR MODIFICATION OF THE STANDARD CONDITIONS OF GAS SUPPLY AND GAS SHIPPER LICENCES

#### To: All holders of a gas supply licence and all holders of a gas shipper licence

On 23 September 2014 the Authority published its decision (and associated modification directions) to proceed with licence modifications to give effect to the Gas Security of Supply Significant Code Review. As part of this decision, the Authority decided to make modifications to the standard conditions of the gas supply and gas shipper licences.

### **Gas supply licence**

The Authority decided to make modifications to the gas supply licence to insert new standard condition 19D. This new condition required gas suppliers to make arrangements to ensure that DSR payments in the event of interruptions would be passed to consumers.

Due to an administrative error, the Authority's modification direction specified an incorrect date for implementation of these amendments. The Authority's modification direction specified that the amendments would take effect on and from 19 November 2014. As set out in our publication entitled 'Gas Security of Supply Significant Code Review – Conclusions' (published 23 September 2014), our intent was for these amendments to take effect on and from 1 October 2015.

We are therefore issuing this correction slip to confirm that the insertion of new standard condition 19D will take effect on and from 1 October 2015.

## Gas shipper licence

The Authority decided to make modifications to the gas shipper licence to insert new standard condition 15A. This new condition required gas shippers to pass DSR payments in the event of interruptions to relevant gas suppliers.

Due to an administrative error, the Authority's modification direction specified an incorrect date for implementation of these amendments. The Authority's modification direction specified that the amendments would take effect on and from 19 November 2014. As set out in our publication entitled 'Gas Security of Supply Significant Code Review – Conclusions' (published 23 September 2014), our intent was for these amendments to take effect on and from 1 October 2015.

We are therefore issuing this correction slip to confirm that the insertion of new standard condition 15A will take effect on and from 1 October 2015.
