secure contracts in the first auction, it is not appropriate to continue to regard them as new projects		
indefinitely. In the long run, for the purpose of justifying New Builds and the refurbishment of units, only		
capital expenditure incurred between T-4 prequalification and the delivery year should be considered.		
It will clearly be necessary to move to this new rule at some point. We think that it would be appropriate		
to do so at this stage, ahead of the second auction.
