<p>Description of the issue that the change proposal seeks to address:</p> <p>With regard to a Refurbishing CMU, the Register only records its Refurbishing status as at the time of pre-qualification and does not record whether a CMU has actually been awarded an agreement as a Refurbishing CMU or an agreement for the Pre-Refurbishment CMU. Hence if a Refurbishing CMU is awarded a 1 year capacity agreement, it cannot be directly determined from the Register whether the agreement is as a Refurbishing or Pre-Refurbishment CMU. A rule change is required to mandate the Delivery Body to include the status of the CMU on the Register after the auction</p>
