Dear Stakeholder,

Feed-in Tariffs: Use of glycerol as a feedstock in anaerobic digestion installations

We have been considering the use of glycerol (sourced as a by-product of the biodiesel industry) in anaerobic digestion (AD) installations supported under the Feed-in Tariff scheme.

We are willing to consider applications for accreditation that propose to use glycerol as a feedstock. Each application will be considered on a case by case basis and must comply fully with the legislation to be accredited under the scheme. Applicants should refer to our [guidance documents](#) to ensure they submit a high quality application.

If applicants plan to use glycerol as a feedstock they must tell us about:

1. the quality of the glycerol they plan to use– ie the typical level of fossil derived impurities present in the glycerol and
2. an estimate of the percentage by mass of glycerol to be added to the digester compared with the mass of other feedstocks.

We will update our AD feedstock template to include these additional requirements.
