

Updated measures table

A revised ECO2 Measures Table was published and now includes Loft Insulation Ceiling: Top-up 100.

The measures table has been updated in line with <u>our guidance</u> <u>note</u> published in June 2015. This enables loft insulation measures to be notified where previous loft insulation has been removed in the six months prior to an RdSAP assessment. The new measure name should be used when notifying these measures from 1 October 2015.

About ECO

ECO is a government scheme to reduce carbon dioxide emissions from Britain's domestic housing and support people living in fuel poverty by funding improvements to homes that make them more energy efficiency improvements in homes.

It places legal obligations on larger energy suppliers to deliver energy efficiency measures to domestic premises in Great Britain. The scheme began in 2013, and the overall obligation period for the second phase of ECO (ECO2) runs from 1 April 2015 to 31 March 2017.

Ofgem E-Serve is the administrator of ECO while DECC is responsible for the policy.
