Monitoring and review of certification

Interconnector (UK) Limited - Notice of opening of a review of certification under section 8(K) of the Gas Act 1986

On 21 May 2013, the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the "Authority"), pursuant to section 8F of the Gas Act 1986 (the "Act"), certified Interconnector (UK) Limited (a company registered in England and Wales under company number 02989838) ("IUK") as independent, under the grounds set out in section:

- (i) 8G(8) of the Act (on the basis that it complied with section 8G(8)(b)(ii) of the Act), from 21 May 2013 until 11.59pm on 2 March 2015; or until it is withdrawn (whichever is earlier); and
- (ii) 8G(3) of the Act, from 12am on 3 March 2015 if not withdrawn prior to that date.

Under section 8K(5) of the Act, the Authority may review whether the certification basis continues to apply if (a) the certified person notifies it of any event or circumstance which may affect that basis; or (b) the Authority thinks that the basis may no longer apply. Based on information received from IUK on 4 March, and in accordance with section 8K of the Act, the Authority has opened a review into IUK's certification.¹

¹ In accordance with section 8(K)(4) of the Act, the review will be carried out within 4 months from the date we received IUK notification, see above. For clarity, pursuant to section 8K(10) of the Act the Authority's four month deadline to reach a decision on our review of IUK's certification will be four months beginning on the day on which we receive the last of the information set out in our requests for information to support our review.
