Prequalification information – Rule 3.4.3

Description of the issue that the change proposal seeks to address:

The current information requirements that applicants must enter during prequalification are insufficient to capture the specific generation and fuel being used for each CMU.

This opaque process is hindering the understanding of what specifically is being procured in the Capacity Market. To increase the transparency, we propose to amend Rule 3.4.3 that states what each applicant must state in the prequalification process to include generation type and fuel type of the CMU.

(vii) generation type of the CMU to which the Application relates; and

(viii) fuel type of the CMU to which the Application relates.
