**Description of the issue that the change proposal seeks to address:**

We believe the CM Register should capture the technology class of a generating CMU and specify its fuel type. In particular this should differentiate between gas and gas oil reciprocating engines. Currently these are captured within one technology class (along with OCGTs)

Amend Rule 7.4.1 to include "Generating Technology Class".  
Amend Schedule 3 "OCGT and reciprocating engine" technology class to differentiate between OCGT, gas reciprocating engines and diesel reciprocating engines

No negative impact. This change will create more transparency of the types of plant winning CM agreements and will allow more accurate technology class assessments (e.g. derating factors may be different for these technologies).
