

Switching Programme validation review, June 2015

- Equivalent to MPA "gateway zero" review
- Three MPA accredited assurance reviewers external to Ofgem
- Review of PID, project plan, risk and issue logs
- Interviews with senior stakeholders including CEO, finance director, programme sponsor, SRO and key team members
- Topics covered:
 - Vision and objectives;
 - Policy Development;
 - Delivery Planning;
 - Governance and Resources;
 - Stakeholders;
 - Benefits Realisation or what success looks like

Review findings


- Broad consensus on overall vision
- Project described as a priority but not funded as such
- Policy focus tended to be on 'happy path'
- PID and project plans had good short-term activity planning
- Accurate and well-written risk register
- No clear timetable for primary legislation to emerge
- 2019 aspiration extremely challenging
- Programme will require new skills/capabilities eg delivery, and industry expertise
- ToRs not developed to outline relationships between governance bodies
- No formal engagement plan for DECC/smart metering team
- No detailed stakeholder plan
