Smart Prepayment for a Smarter Market: Our Proposals

The Electricity Prepayment Metering Forum (PPMF) welcomes this opportunity to respond to Ofgem's consultation regarding smart prepayment metering. PPMF is a membership organisation established to provide a forum for the exchange of, and discussion on, matters relating to all types of electricity prepayment meters. The Forum exists to provide expertise in technical, operational and regulatory issues that impact the operation of prepayment meter supply businesses. In addition, the Forum recently convened a Smart Prepayment Metering Forum in order to provide the industry with a platform to discuss the implementation of smart meters, the associated governance and the technical and operational issues that may occur.
