## Nemo Link Response to Ofgem's Nemo Licence Consultation

Following a constructive regulatory dialog Nemo Link (Nemo) welcomes the opportunity to respond to Ofgem's consultation on proposed changes to the standard conditions of the electricity interconnector licence, licences held by Nemo Link and NGIL and NGET's electricity transmission licence to implement the cap and floor regime and use of revenues compliance. Nemo Link, as a joint venture of National Grid Interconnector Holdings Limited and Elia is committed to delivering a successful cap and floor interconnector project by target completion date of 31 January 2019.
