

The latest monthly update shows that 73,723 loft insulation measures and 16,415 room in roof insulation measures have been delivered under ECO2 since April 2015.




ECO monitoring consultation open

BEIS' ECO monthly statistical release

The Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) has published their latest ECO statistics.

These show that 27,239 measures were installed in July. Since 2013, 691,659 cavity wall insulation measures have also been installed under the scheme.

About ECO

ECO is a government scheme to reduce carbon dioxide emissions from Britain's domestic housing and support people living in fuel poverty by funding energy efficiency improvements.

It places legal obligations on larger energy suppliers to deliver energy efficiency measures to domestic premises in Great Britain. The scheme began in 2013, and the overall obligation period for the second phase of ECO (ECO2) runs from 1 April 2015 to 31 March 2017.

Ofgem E-Serve is the administrator of ECO while BEIS is responsible for the policy.
