Rule 3.4.7 requires CMUs to declare that they are not accredited under a Low Carbon Exclusion.				
Description of the issue that the change proposal se	eks to address:			
Low Carbon Exclusions often apply to entire sites even if only a proportion of that site actually benefits from that Low Carbon Exclusion. The CM Rules allow sites to nominate metering behind a Grid Connection to participate in the CM. Where such sites share a gird connection meter with a non-CM site with a low carbon exclusion, it should be possible for the portion of that site not benefiting from the low carbon exemption to participate in the CM.				
If applicable, please state the proposed revised drafting (please highlight the change): Rule 3.4.7 should be updated to allow CMUs which form part of sites which benefit from Low Carbon Exclusions but do not themselves benefit from Low Carbon Exclusions, to participate in the CM.				
Analysis and evidence on the impact on industry and/or consumers including any risks to note when making the revision - including, any potential implications for industry codes:				
This currently represents a barrier to smaller embedded generators or DSR from participating in the CM. Currently the only way to participate for such sites is to install new and expensive additional metering.
