Rule 8.3.3(c) states that the Delivery Body must “notify the relevant Capacity Provider whether or not, based on such Metering Assessment, the metering arrangements for such CMU will be subject to a Metering Test”.

**Description of the issue that the change proposal seeks to address:**

The rules should clarify how the Delivery Body determines where or not a metering test is required. For example, where a CMU participates in a relevant balancing service and has had its metering approved for this, we believe a further Metering Test in the CM is unnecessary.
