DIRECTION ISSUED BY THE GAS AND ELECTRICITY MARKETS AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH AA.1 OF SPECIAL CONDITION AA OF THE ELECTRICITY GENERATION LICENCE GRANTED OR TREATED AS GRANTED UNDER SECTION 6(1)(a) OF THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

Whereas:

- The companies to whom this Direction is addressed ("the licensees") hold a generation licence ("the licence") granted or treated as granted pursuant to section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989 ("the Act"), in which special condition AA (Liquidity in the Wholesale Electricity Market) ("the condition") has effect.
- 2. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") has the power pursuant to paragraph AA.1 of the condition to direct that paragraphs AA.2 to AA.6 of the condition shall cease to have effect from such date as the Authority may specify.
- 3. The Authority has today published a letter titled 'Decision to Modify Special Condition AA of E.ON's and Uniper's Electricity Generation Licences'. In accordance with section 49A of the Act, this letter gives the Authority's reasons for making this Direction and our conclusion that, following the spin-off of Uniper SE by E.ON SE on 12 September 2016, the licensees no longer meet the criteria for complying with the condition, as set out in Ofgem's Liquidity Guidance¹.

Now therefore:

- 4. The Authority hereby directs that paragraphs AA.2 to AA.6 of the condition shall cease to have effect for the licensees.
- 5. This direction shall take effect on 30 November 2016 and remain in effect until such time as the Authority may revoke, vary or replace it by a further direction.
