Removal of the need for Supplier letters for non-CMRS CMUs with bespoke metering

What the proposal relates to and if applicable, what current provision of Rules the proposal relates to (please state provision number):

Rule 3.6.1 (c) requires Non-CMRS CMUs using Bespoke Metering Configuration Solution to provide a letter from the supplier or former supplier confirming the net output. For many CMUs the supplier will be unable to verify 'behind the meter' output.

Description of the issue that the change proposal seeks to address:

If a supplier is unable to verify the output of behind the meter generation, an Applicant should be able to provide other evidence of historic net output.
